Pope Francis and the New Evangelization

Fr. Robert Barron will talk about how to put faith into action in today's increasingly secular world. With Pope Francis as a model of how to present "the joy of the Gospel," Barron will argue that Catholics have a duty to awaken the faith of the baptized and bring back those who have drifted. While the message has remained unchanged since the first century, Catholics are called to share the beauty, goodness, and truth of the faith with new ardor, new expressions, and new methods that will reach the disenchanted and bring people closer to Christ and to his Church.

Robert Barron is a priest of the Archdiocese of Chicago and the founder of Word on Fire Catholic Ministries, a media group dedicated to the new evangelization. He is also creator and host of "Catholicism", a ten-part documentary on the Catholic faith, and serves as Rector/President of the University of Saint Mary of the Lake/Mundelein Seminary.
